#### STEP UP FOR STUDENTS:

**STEP 1:** Apply or Renew Scholarships with Step Up for Students (SUFS). This information is provided as a courtesy and is a separate application process from WCA's. Step Up for Students is a state approved non-profit organization that helps to administer scholarships for Florida schoolchildren and is available to EVERY Student. Per the Step Up for Students website, the steps outlined below will help you navigate how to apply and please note that errors when applying can lead to potential delays.

**STEP 2:** Once a SUFS scholarship is awarded to your student, click [\[HERE\]](#) to provide the Award Identification Number, Scholarship Program Name, and Scholarship Award Amount to the Student Finance Department.

**STEP 3:** Once the scholarship for you student has been approved through the Warner Christian Academy EMA Portal, the scholarship will then be applied to the tuition payment plan account. **Please note that parents are responsible for any remaining balance that is not covered by Step Up for Students Scholarship Funds.**

#### TUITION ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE:

Warner Christian Academy (K-12) now offers four tuition assistance options. Families interested in applying must **submit an application** to the Student Finance Department by **August 15** to be considered for 100% tuition assistance for the full academic year, or by **January 15** to be considered for 50% tuition assistance for the second semester. Deadlines are firm to ensure proper enrollment in these programs. Please note: **Applications do not guarantee that tuition assistance will be awarded. Funds are limited and capped with awards distributed on a first-come, first-served basis after qualification is verified.**

- ❖ **Front-Line & Military Veteran Scholarship:** Up to \$500 tuition assistance is offered to parents who work full-time (active-duty) in the following professions: law enforcement, firefighters, nurses, paramedics, and teachers. Veterans and Military Service Personnel are also eligible for this scholarship. The tuition assistance will be applied after Step Up for Students is applied to the student's tuition payment plan, not including curriculum or additional program fees.
- ❖ **Pastoral Scholarship:** Ordained Pastors/Missionaries who are actively serving in that capacity will receive a 50% off tuition assistance on the remaining tuition balance, not including curriculum or additional program fees. The Tuition assistance will be applied after Step Up for Students is applied to the student's tuition payment plan.
- ❖ **Legacy Scholarship:** Up to \$500 tuition assistance is offered to parents who are WCA alumni (graduated from WCA). The Tuition assistance will be applied after Step Up for Students is applied to the student's tuition payment plan, not including curriculum or additional program fees.
- ❖ **White Chapel Church Scholarship:** White Chapel Church Members (defined as attending at least 2x/month for 6 months and, ongoing and consistent stewardship), can apply for a 50% off tuition assistance on the remaining tuition balance, not including curriculum or additional program fees. The Tuition assistance will be applied after Step Up for Students is applied to the student's tuition payment plan.

**Please contact the Student Finance Department for details on how to qualify and/or apply for any of the tuition assistance listed above.**

**Note:** Parental/guardian placed private school students with a disability do not have an individual right to receive some or all of the special education and related services that the student would receive if enrolled in a public school under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
