FAMILIES THAT QUALIFY:

- Students of families with higher income (i.e. nearly \$111,000 for a family of 4)
- Apply Scholarships Step Up For Students
- Siblings of students who receive the Family Empowerment Scholarship (formerly Gardiner)
- Dependent children of a member of the United States Armed Forces, including Reservists
- Students with one of the following diagnoses: speech impairment; language impairment; orthopedic
 impairment; other health impairment; emotional or behavioral disability; or specific learning disability,
 including but not limited to dyslexia, dyscalculia, or developmental aphasia

- Must be applied for immediately after being accepted as a WCA student as there are limited funds.
- FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment is the financial aid company for WCA.
- Must be verified with W-2's and taxes upload, fax, or mail all supporting documentation.
- To apply:
 - 1. Click this link: https://factsmgt.com/
 - 2. At top right of screen click "Parent Log in"
 - a. In the drop-down menu Click "FACTS Family Portal"
 - 3. Log in to your family portal (district code: WCA-FL)
 - a. Fill in your username and password
 - b. Click "Log In"
 - 4. Click "Financial" on the bottom left navigational bar
 - 5. Under the Financial Links box, click on "Apply for Grant & Aid" link
 - 6. Click on "create an account" if you do not already have one (separate account must be created for Grant and aid application)
 - 7. Type in your email address- click "Create a New Account"
 - 8. Create new Username and password, click "next"
 - 9. Fill in Fields (name, address, phone etc.) and click "Submit"
 - 10. Start application for Grant and Aid
